## **The Do's and Don'ts of Camping (aka How to Make Camping Enjoyable for Everyone)**

- 1) Book your campsite and don't take someone else's site just because they have not arrived (yet).
- 2) Keep your distance from other campsites if possible and don't go walking through other people's sites. We enjoy our peace and privacy when we camp.
- 3) Clean up your campsite before you leave. Leave no food lying around. Bury or preferably burn toilet paper if there is no toilet. Use the trash bins for trash or take your trash with you if there are no bins. Don't leave hot coals on the fire.
- 4) Do not cut down trees for firewood in the campsite (or along the way). Either bring your own from home or purchase some at the entrance to the campsite or national park/game reserve.
- 5) Use the designated fire pits for your fires. You don't want your flames to spread and harm yourself, your family or your surroundings.
- 6) Keep all noise in camp to a minimum. No loud laughter or shouting. Teach your kids to respect the tradition of camping, which means no screaming and shouting. No generators...at all...whatsoever. No loud music from the stereo system or live instruments.
